Just lost your health insurance?

You may be able to sign up for health insurance with a Special Enrollment Period.

What is a Special Enrollment Period?

A Special Enrollment Period is a time, other than Open Enrollment, when you can sign up for health insurance through healthcare.gov. You have 60 days to apply after you lose your existing health coverage.

How much will the insurance cost?

- The cost depends on your annual income projection, not your current income. Unemployment benefits count.
- Nearly 90% of people qualify for financial help.
- Some plans are available with a zero monthly cost.
